Limited to 4-H and FFA members or registered Independents of Colusa County.

Entry Deadline:

Thursday, April 9, 2019 11:59 pm online

Entry Fee: \$10.00 Per Class

Rules: (NOTE: See Rules at beginning of Junior Livestock Department)

1. All market hogs must be individually owned by the exhibitor no later than Thursday, April 9, 2019.
2. Gilts entered in the market hog division may not be entered in the breeding divisions, or vice versa. Any violations of this rule will exclude the offending exhibitor from competition in all departments of the fair.
3. Market hogs may be shown clipped or with natural hair.
4. Only animals judged Market Acceptable will be eligible for the JLA.
5. Market animals not meeting the minimum weight requirement have until 7:00 pm on Tuesday, June 9, 2019 to leave the grounds.
6. *Classes will be broken by weight and breed that consists of five or more animals of the same breed to justify its own division in 4-h and FFA. If there are less than 4 purebreds of a certain breed, they will compete in the All Other Breeds division. Breed of the animal will be determined by exhibitors submitting a picture of the registration papers by the entry deadline. All hogs without registration papers will be put into the crossbred division.*
7. *All Division winners will compete for Champion Market Hog.*
8. Only one item can be sold at auction

Market HOG Scorecard Danish Judging System Market Ready (Blue Ribbon): U.S. No. 1 and No. 2 hogs of average or greater conformation that are acceptable in leanness, muscularity and production traits.

Not Market Ready (Red Ribbon): Any hog of below average conformation including U.S. number 3, U.S. number 4 and utility grade hogs.
